- Install and maintain IP networking equipment (routers, switches, firewalls, etc.)
- Create and maintain up-to-date site documentation resulting from engineering activities and contractor work orders.
- Test, verify and report on wireless network RF performance using standard RF measurement tools (e.g., spectrum analyzers, signal meters). Perform drive testing.
- Maintain and equip the work vehicle with the required tools, parts and test equipment.
- Test and perform commissioning of new wireless Point of Presence (POP) sites and help to identify performance deficiencies.
- Create and maintain incident and fault reports. Act upon and assist in resolving the reported issues.
- Interface with other entities (e.g., network operators, equipment suppliers, OmniGlobe and contractor personnel, customers) to respond to inquiries and identify and resolve network problems.
- Be available for shift/standby work (e.g., 24-hour emergency technical support rotation).
- Implement preventative site and equipment maintenance routines.

Qualifications
